Don't risk losing your house...teach your children by example by showing them proper behavior towards others.

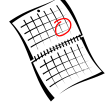

## MOLD

Mold can be a serious problem and cause harm to you and your family. Sometimes mold can be hard to detect. A musty or earthy smell is one sign of mold. Mold can be any color and is often staining and fuzzy. Wet spots, dampness, or water leaks may lead to infestations of mold.

It is important to get rid of mold in your home as quickly as possible. Clean areas by wiping them down with detergent solution such as Tilex or any other mold or mildew cleaner or bleach. Be sure to dry the area after wiping it down.

Mold can be hard to get rid of but easy to prevent. Keep your home dry and the humidity low. Report any water leaks immediately. Get rid of clutter. Clean your house regularly.

## **SAVE ENERGY**

Air conditioners are the biggest users of electricity. Save energy by:

- \* Closing outside doors and windows during hot periods of the day and when the air conditioner is on;
- \* Closing window shades and drapes;
- \* Turning off the air conditioner when not at home or on mildly warm days;
- \* Using the stove as little as possible.

## **Conserve Water Tips**

- Report all water leaks, drips no matter how small
- Do not use the hose to clean sidewalks
- Don't let children play unattended with hoses
- Keep swimming pools filled with a lower amount of water to reduce the amount of water splashed.
