Plumbing Care

<u>Never</u> pour cooking oil or other greasy materials down the drains. Oils and grease used in cooking may be liquid after use, but they can harden inside pipes and cause blockages. Instead of pouring grease down the drain, wipe it off the pot or pan with a paper towel, place a slice of bread in it to soak the grease up and throw it away or pour cooled oil and fats into a non-recyclable container and then dispose with the trash.

Avoid putting feminine products and baby wipes down the toilet. They will not only plug your toilet but also plug the sewer line.

Please make your family aware of what should and should not be put down the drain. If maintenance finds the clog is due to tenant neglect, you will be charged.

Fall is on the way...take a look around your house. How much clutter and debris do you have lying around? How your yard looks is not only a reflection or you and your neighbors, but also the Housing Authority. In the near future, Newark Housing Authority staff will be going around and looking at the condition of the property. If your lawn falls into the above category, you may get a letter from the office stating that it needs to be picked up. **Take pride in your home and pick up!!**
